



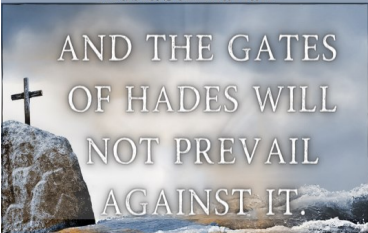

The 145th Congregational Annual Meeting will be held this Sunday, January 28th after the 10:35 a.m. Worship Service.

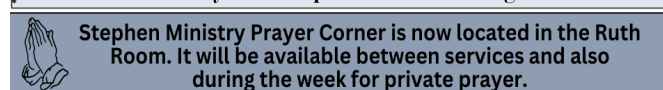
