Dear Members of First St. Paul's.

Lent is one of two penitential seasons of the church year (the other being Advent,) when we usually ask people to do a little self-reflection, a little soul searching, a time to focus on our own sin, our sorrow over having committed them, and our commitment to do better. And while all those things are good and valuable, we have noticed that we never really ask the church to do the same. So this year, in a more dialogical style of presentation, we will express our remorse for the sins of the church over the centuries. We are sorry for Believing the Earth was Flat (and resisting the truths of science.) We are sorry for the Inquisition (and all the ways we condoned oppression.) We are sorry for the Crusades (and other ways we believed violence was a part of God's plan.) We are sorry for our Endorsement of Slavery (and any other ways all people were not regarded as equal.) We are sorry for not immediately, forcefully, and clearly condemning Hitler (and other ways we looked to our own preservation.) And we are sorry for our willingness to Inject Politics into the Gospel (and other ways we have allowed the world to affect our message.)

While all these thing may be interesting, even introspective, we still invite you to commit to or recommit to daily prayer and Bible readings, to sacrificial giving through the Judas purse, and to regular worship.
